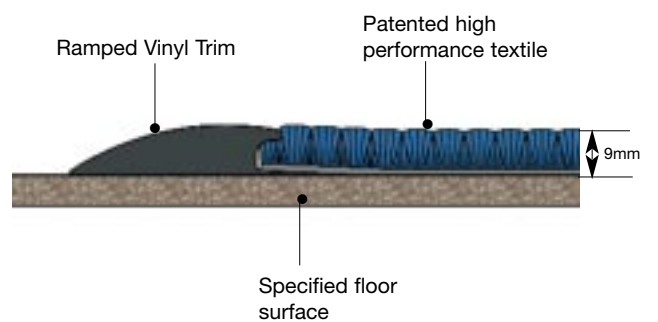


Fire rated vinyl (VFR) backing
